Engineering

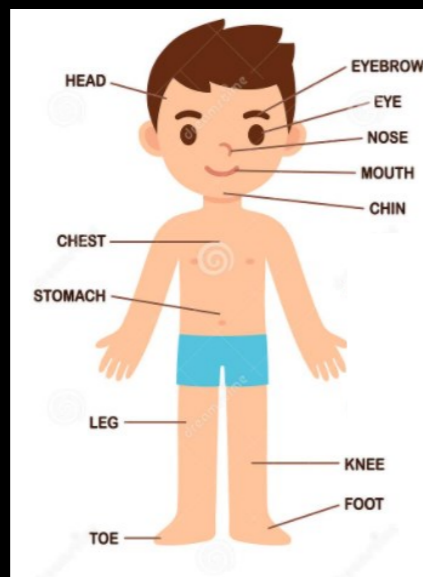
Balanced diet - is a diet that includes a variety of different types of foods, providing all of the nutrients needed.

Landmark - an object or feature of a landscape that is easily seen from a distance.

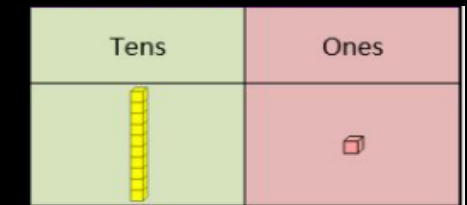
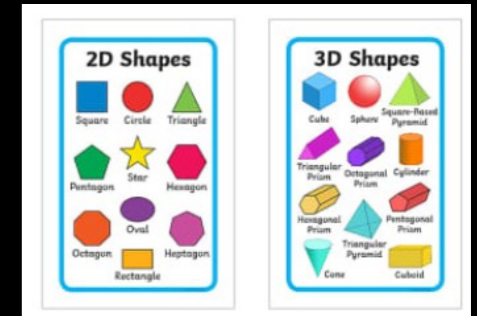
Maths

A 2D shape - is a shape with two dimensions - length and width. 'They are completely flat.'

A 3D shape - is a shape with three dimensions - length, width and height. 'They are quite simply flat.'

Face - flat surface of a solid shape.

Phonics

Diagraph - Two letters that make a single sound (ai, ee, oo)

Trigraph - Three letters that make a single sound (igh, air, dge)

Split diagraph - A digraph separated by a consonant. (a-e, e-e)

English

Narrative - A written or spoken account of events which can be fiction or non-fiction.

Fiction - A text which is made up; you need to use your imagination to read/write it.

A traditional tale is a story that has been told and re-told for many years, and so becomes a story that almost everyone knows. E.g. Little Red Riding Hood
