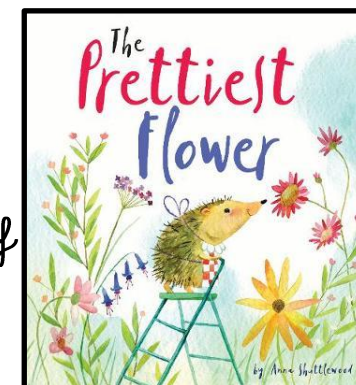

WONDERS of the World

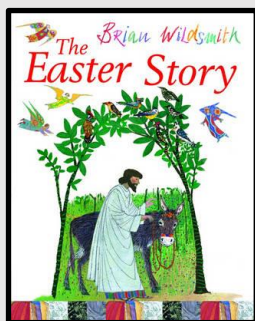


Values Driver: The book which will **broaden** our repertoire of books we read through daily story time and represents our Wyndham values of forgiveness and honesty.

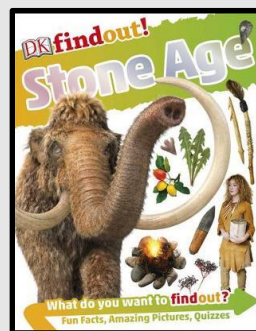


This book centres on the key themes of forgiveness and honesty. These themes are explored through the main character, Hedgehog, and how her beautiful garden is unexpectedly ruined during the night. Without evidence, Hedgehog blames her friends; Mole, Duck and Hare causing upset through false accusations. Once the evidence shows it was the caterpillar who, initially denies the wrong doing, but then owns up and is honest, Hedgehog realises she needs to apologise and ask for forgiveness from her friends. The honesty shown by the caterpillar and the forgiveness expressed by the Hedgehog results in a beautiful friendship. This story enables pupils to interrupt the forgetting of concepts previously taught in the Spring term, such naming and identifying common wild and garden plants. Additionally, it links to a previously taught Wyndham Value of responsibility.
