Maths

We will also be using Times Table Rock Stars to develop our multiplication and division knowledge in class and at home to ensure we become fluent in all 12 times tables.

In PE, we will be learning the skills needed to take part in OAA such as playing teamwork games and introducing tactical thinking.

In RE, we will be revisiting our learning on Christianity, exploring the origins of the religion and linking our learning with the Romans. We will be thinking about how Christians worship and why it is important to them.

In Science, we will be looking at the topic of electricity through exploring what a conductor and insulator is and how a circuit works.
