

STEM

- **Science**
 - Use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating
 - Demonstrate that dissolving, mixing and changes of state are reversible changes
 - Explain that some changes result in the formation of new materials (usually irreversible).
 - Plan different types of scientific enquiries to answer questions, including recognising and controlling variables where necessary.
- **Design & Technology**
 - I am able to show that I am hygienic when working with, and around, food.
 - I am able to show that I can work safely with kitchen appliances when using food.
- **Computing**
 - Use a variety of layouts, formatting, sounds, graphics and illustrations, transitions, video and animations to create outcomes for different purposes or audiences
